Diversity and Equality Policy

The Wine School @ Anglotime Diversity and Equality Policy assures equality of opportunity for candidates by the following examples of a non-exhaustive list:

- Promoting open access to WSET qualifications
- Not discriminating against any member, applicant or candidate because of race, colour, national or ethnic origin, age, religion, disability, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, family composition, veteran status or any other characteristic.
- Ensuring that the format and content of all specifications, exams and other WSET materials do not discriminate unlawfully against anyone on the previous points above.
- Allowing candidates with special needs, disabilities or temporary injuries to access WSET assessments without changing the demands of the assessment
- Ensuring that this policy is taken into account during the development of a new qualification and other WSET projects

If the candidates believe they have been unfairly discriminated against by an APP in the first instance this should be raised with the APP concerned by email or letter to: wineschool@anglotime.com or by post to: The Wine School @ Anglotime, 70 Rue du Faubourg St Nicolas, 21200, Beaune. Any APP or candidate who has a concern that actions of an individual connected to the delivery of the WSET qualifications is against the WSET code of conduct, they can report this to WSET by contacting qu@wsetglobal.com. Please note that only after all attempts for resolution per the APP policy, which includes an appeal, can the complaint be raised with WSET.
